Construction and Utilities Career Day is designed to show high school students the career opportunities and potential for growth in the construction and utility trades. The event is about Youth, Industry & Partnership.

The next event is scheduled for **Thursday, September 27, 2018**. Up to 450 local high school students are expected to attend and receive a hands-on introduction to the range of opportunities open to them in the construction and utilities industry.

Come make positive connections with high schools students. Many are ready to take the next steps to build a career in the trades and your participation is vital! With the strong need for future workers, it is important for students to consider the trades as a viable, living wage career. Construction and Utilities Career Days is designed to do just that by showcasing a friendly, exciting, and professional industry that cares about them and their future. The day will be filled with hands-on activities that educate young people about the industry by providing fun, hands-on learning opportunities, and giving them the chance to apply what they are learning in their high school classrooms to real life situations.

Career Days events include three areas of participation:

- **Booth Exhibits** provide valuable information for the students and educators. Contractors, utilities, state agencies, trade apprenticeship programs, and two- and four-year colleges will be among the booth exhibitors.
- **Hands-On Activities** are opportunities for students to try performing job-related skills and functions in a controlled environment, such as finishing concrete, setting tile, rebar-tying, climbing power poles, installing utilities, and more!
- **Heavy Equipment** will include both static equipment with operators available to explain the nature of their job and the industry; and operating equipment where the students, under the guidance of a trained operator, can actually run the equipment in a controlled, safe environment under skilled direction.
